

Jean-François Huchet is currently Professor of Economics at the University of Rennes 2. He was based in Asia for 14 years and has occupied several academic positions as senior research fellow at the French Centre for Research on Contemporary China (Centre d'études français sur la Chine contemporaine, CEFC) in Hong Kong between 1997 – 2001 and was vice-editor of *Perspectives chinoises* and *China Perspectives.*, during this period. He was also senior research fellow at the Maison franco-japonaise in Tokyo between 1994 - 1997. He has published numerous articles on the Chinese economy, especially on the reform of the State-Owned enterprises. He is also co-author of 2 books : *Gouvernance, coopération et stratégie des firmes chinoises*, Paris, L'Harmattan, 2005, 212 p. and *Japanese management system under the globalisation Era*, Springer, 1998. He has received his PhD of economics from the University of Rennes 1.
